Apalachicola Riverkeeper is dedicated to the protection, restoration, and stewardship of the Apalachicola River and Apalachicola Bay. We are often the only line of defense against environmental degradation of the River and Bay, advocating at the grassroots level, with state legislators and regulators, in the courts, and in the halls of Congress.

Efforts include:

- A multi-year <u>slough restoration</u> <u>project</u> to benefit the river floodplain and East Bay
- Water quality monitoring and microplastics sampling.
- The annual <u>RiverTrek</u> public outreach and fundraising campaign.
- Monthly <u>eco-educational hiking</u> <u>and kayak outings</u> throughout the Basin.
- Area cleanup efforts that remove tons of trash and debris.
- <u>Legally challenging the Army Corps of Engineers' Environmental Impact</u> Study (EIS).
- Fighting oil and gas drilling activities in the Apalachicola River Basin.
- River patrol and visual survey monitoring.
- Advocacy with <u>regional stakeholders</u>, conservation allies and 13 other <u>Florida Waterkeepers</u>.
